

IPM Plan guidance

There is **no manned service desk** for IPM plan queries, so please read the information below carefully before contacting us, as most issues can be resolved using this guidance.

The IPM plans are designed to be completed **online** so that:

- an IPM score can be generated
 - feedback can be provided
 - IPM uptake across the industry can be measured and inform future policy
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Saving your progress

- If you **do not expect to complete the plan in one sitting**, you **must enable cookies** on your device.
- Your draft IPM plan will be saved using cookies.
- When you return to the page at a later date, a message should automatically appear allowing you to continue from your saved draft.
- You may also be able to find the link in your browser history.

Important:

Do **not** clear your browser history or cookies if you wish to return to a saved draft. If cookies or history are removed, your draft **cannot be recovered**.

Problems moving to the next page?

If you are experiencing issues progressing through the plan:

1. Clear your browser cache, history and cookies
2. Restart your browser
3. Enable cookies on the IPM page of the website and try again

In many cases, this resolves the problem.

Claiming Continuing Professional Development Points

BASIS and NRoSO members may claim CPD points upon completion of the IPM plan. To enable this, please complete the CPD declaration section at the end of the questionnaire.

Up to **three BASIS points** and **two NRoSO points** are available. Where valid membership information is provided, CPD points will be claimed on your behalf.

Submission of your plan

Where an email address is provided, you will receive a PDF copy of your completed IPM plan, which includes:

- your IPM score
- the date the plan was completed
- your responses to the questionnaire
- feedback to support improvements in your integrated pest management approach

Please note that this feedback is not region-specific.

If no email address is provided, you will be prompted to download a copy of your plan after submitting. **You must retain a copy of your completed annual IPM plan as evidence of compliance.**

Basic farm payment

The Plant Health Centre does not administer or verify Single Application Form or Single Farm Payment claims. To meet requirements, you must:

- declare within your Single Application Form that an IPM plan has been completed for the relevant claim year, and
- retain a copy of your IPM plan so it can be produced on request during an inspection or compliance check.

Completion of an IPM plan is a component of the **Whole Farm Plan requirements** for Scottish agricultural support schemes. Full guidance on Whole Farm Plan obligations is available on the

 - Word versions **do not include an IPM score or feedback**.
